

## Bussage C of E Primary School

The Pupil Premium is a specific amount of funding that forms part of our annual budget. It is intended to tackle the inequalities between children eligible for free school meals and their peers.

15 children were eligible **15 x £1,320 = £19,800** We also received a further in year payment of **£280** Making a grand total of **£20,080** The table shows how we spent our PP in the financial year **April 2015 – April 2016** and the impact.
