Sports Premium 2015-16

2013/14 the Government launched its Sports Premium funding. This funding must be used in the 2014/15 academic year to fund improvements to the provision of PE and sport, for the benefit of pupils aged 5-11 years old so that all pupils develop healthy lifestyles.

The money is allocated to initiatives to ensure that all children reach their true potential, both academically and socially.

In 2015/16 we received £8,860 of Sport Premium funding. This money will be used to help provide the following:

£2,890	Kick Off Stroud	Staff training and Gym PE lessons
£300	Ninja Tots	After school club provisions for KS1
£800	Tennis Coach	Paid for a tennis coach to teach KS2 with staff in on activities for CPD.
£1,465	Sporting Day	Whole school "extreme sports" Climbing Wall, Skate Park, Circus Skills, Skipping external provider.
£1,995	Purchase of Real PE resources	These will be rolled out to staff in 2016-17 with twilights, new resources and an increase in teaching confidence and skills in delivering PE across the school.
£502	Cirencester Pool and transport	Y 5/6 top up swimming for poor/weak swimmers
£135	Coach to Stroud	Year 2 participation in Kick-off Stroud
£160	New Equipment	Footballs
£150	KS1 Inter-sports	Travel costs
£300	Purchase of staff equipment	PE kit to enhance the image of PE through being corporate
£163	Sports Day sundries	Stickers etc.

Sport has continued to be a priority. Feedback from parents regarding the extra activities provided through funding is positive with children being exposed to new activities.
