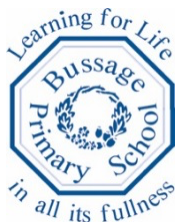

Background	Following the partial closure of all schools in March 2020 – June 2020 and then the gradual increase in numbers to full reopening of schools in September 2020, it was widely recognised that as a result of children being unable to access high quality first teaching and feedback, gaps in learning were inevitable. The response was for Government COVID Catch Up Funding for every school amounting to £80 per child on roll at the time of the October 2019 census. £15,760

Wave 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Year 2 Phonics Catch up sessions with experienced teacher 2 afternoons a week using our new Phonics Tracker to accurately identify gaps and pinpoint areas to focus. To ensure children are ready for KS1 Autumn Phonics Check. (D.C. 10 weeks of 2 afternoons = £1,455) Year 2 Catch-up / Year 1 Phonics Catch up sessions with experienced teacher 2 afternoons a week in English and mathematics Y2 and Phonics Y1 to accurately identify gaps and pinpoint areas to focus. (D.C. 15 weeks of 2 afternoons = £2,180) Year 3/4 Catch-up Catch up sessions with experienced teacher/HLTA 1 day a week English and mathematics (L.B. 20 weeks £3,820) Year 5/6 Catch-up Catch up sessions with experienced teacher 1 day a week English and mathematics (P.H. 20 weeks £3,635)
